Peter Davies was born in Liverpool and qualified from Liverpool Medical School in 1955.

After completing house officer posts at Walton Hospital, he became a partner in general practice in Netherton in 1963. At the time the practice list consisted of 3,600 patients shared between two partners and no employees apart from a caretaker who took messages. Peter became a senior partner in 1978 and on his retirement in 1990, the practice had grown considerably and had 10,300 patients shared by five partners, full staff

attachments and a number of ancillary staff.

Peter had a close working relationship with the community, medical and nursing staff and the psychiatric social workers and community psychiatric nurses and specialist clinics in psychiatry and obstetrics, amongst others, were held at the practice.
